Crozet Arts Covid-19 Protocols & Waiver (updated August 2022)

Signature required of parent or student (if over age 18) prior to class or workshop session.

Please read the information below and then sign this waiver prior to participating in classes at Crozet Arts. This waiver pertains to 15 August 2022 - 31 May 2023 classes, workshops, or other meetings at Crozet Arts.

CROZET ARTS COVID-19 ABATEMENT STEPS (Summer 2021 - present):

- Adherence to CDC and Blue Ridge Health Department recommendations for surface cleaning and air exchange
- In-depth consultations with our medical advisors
- Installation of an ALEN air purifier in each studio, and hallway, running 24/7 for air filtration
- New A/C units installed in each studio
- Water pipes flushed and water testing in bathrooms
- Taped-off individual floor and barre spaces for students in the Dance Studio
- Individual workplaces in the Art Studio, with 6' distancing
- Classrooms will allow for distancing at all times; protocols will vary for different kinds of classes.
- Ballet barres will be wiped down between classes.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in hallways and studios.

COVID PROTOCOLS FOR CROZET ARTS CLASSES/WORKSHOPS/MEETINGS:

- All students (ages 6 months & up) enrolled in group classes must present proof of Covid vaccination at or before first class meeting. Photo of vaccination card may be emailed to CrozetArts@gmail.com (Sharon Tolczyk) prior to first class meeting. *Please note:* Crozet Arts does not store vaccination card info. All students must present proof of Covid vaccination for 2022-2023 classes even if proof was presented in 2021-2022 or Summer 2022.
- Masks must be worn by <u>everyone</u> over the age of 2 to enter, and while inside, Crozet Arts. Students and families will be notified in writing if this policy changes, reflecting greatly reduced community spread, and per advisement of our medical team.
- Please use hand sanitizer in hallway upon entering.
- Students and teachers will wear masks throughout class, other than for distanced water/snack breaks.
- We are following the current CDC guidelines for students who develop symptoms of illness:

Staying Home When Sick

People with symptoms of infectious diseases, including COVID-19, <u>influenza</u>, respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), and gastrointestinal infections should stay home and get tested for COVID-19.
